Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Surrey Security Service Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Surrey Security Service Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero carbon emissions by 2050 for its UK operations, in line with UK Government targets and PPN 06/21 requirements.

This commitment is endorsed at Board level and is embedded within our operational, procurement, and fleet management strategies.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 2023

Surrey Security Service had not previously been required to produce a formal Carbon Reduction Plan under PPN 06/21. As such, 2023 is used as our baseline year, representing the first full reporting period for organisational carbon emissions.

The baseline reflects emissions primarily generated through:

Company vehicle use and mobile patrols

Purchased electricity for offices and operations

Business travel and supply chain activities

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to **150 tCO₂e** by **2028**.

This is a reduction of 29.9%

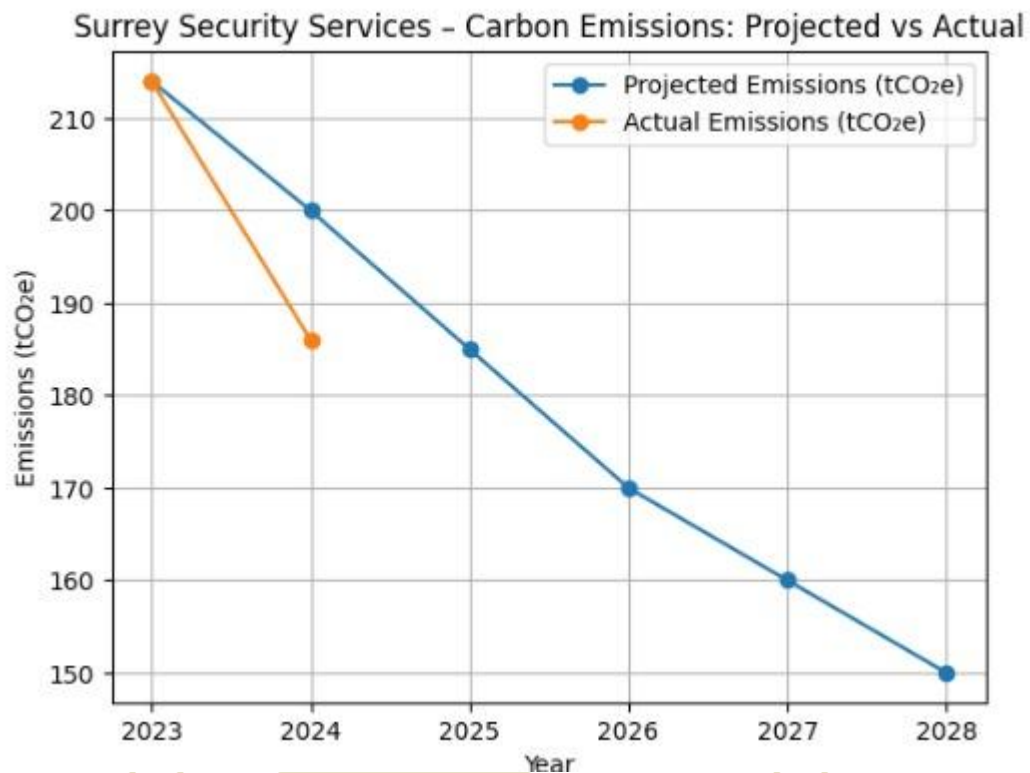
Progress against these targets can be seen in the graph below:

Projected emissions:

Gradual, credible reduction trajectory toward ~150 tCO₂e by 2028

We have visual evidence that we are already outperforming early projections and that our reduction is planned, measured, and realistic

“Progress against our carbon reduction targets is monitored annually and tracked through projected versus actual emissions performance, as illustrated in Figure X. Actual emissions for 2024 demonstrate performance ahead of our planned reduction trajectory.”



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to **28 tCO₂e**, a **13%** reduction against the 2023 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract

The following measures have already been implemented and will be in effect when delivering the CPC contract:

Transition to hybrid and electric vehicles for mobile patrols where operationally viable

Route optimisation to reduce fuel usage and mileage

Increased use of remote management and digital reporting (Surrey Protect 360) to reduce travel

Reduction in paper usage through digital incident and audit reporting

LED lighting and energy-efficiency controls at operational offices

Waste segregation and responsible disposal through licensed contractors

These measures have contributed to an estimated reduction of 28 tCO₂e, equating to a 13% reduction against the baseline.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

Surrey Security Service Ltd plans to implement further measures including:

Continued expansion of fully electric patrol vehicles and scooters

Engagement with suppliers to reduce Scope 3 emissions

Formalisation of an Environmental Management System aligned to ISO 14001 principles

Increased use of local recruitment to reduce travel emissions

Annual carbon footprint reviews and reporting

Declaration and Sign Off
